ADMISSIONS

14 bachelor degrees are offered, and with the opening of residential housing in the Fall of 2009, we are now transitioning into a residential campus. Currently admission is Open Enrollment. Fall deadline for admission is July 15 (date subject to change). All students graduating college prep or tech prep are eligible for enrollment. Students graduating with tech prep diplomas will need to fulfill deficiencies. Students scoring 500 Math 450 Critical Reading on SAT or 21 Math 19 English on ACT will be exempted from Compass Placement Exam requirement. All other students will be required to take the Compass Exam for placement purposes. Application can be completed online with 20 dollar fee. Paper applications are also available and can be completed for a 30 dollar fee.
