SCHOLARSHIPS

Young Harris College has an outstanding merit-based scholarship program that recognizes students for academic, athletic and fine arts abilities. Need based aid is also available, and students are strongly encouraged to file that FAFSA as soon as possible after January 1. The HOPE scholarship supplements \$4,000/year^o toward the cost of attendance for eligible students. The Georgia Tuition Equalization Grant (GTEG) is awarded to Georgia residents in the amount of \$1,500/year^o. Merit scholarships and HOPE are renewable for subsequent years provided the student maintains a 3.0 GPA.
